

## SERVICES FOR HIKERS

*These services are offered to autonomous hikers on the IAT*

### • **Baggage transport**

Upon reservation and under certain conditions we offer a baggage and supply transport system for long hikes. On average, you can count from \$35 to \$45 per person per stop-over point. Minimum 4 people. Estimation upon request!

### • **Car shuttle service**

Upon reservation and under certain conditions, in the Matane Wildlife Reserve, we offer a service which allows you to leave your car at the end of your hiking or biking trail. The price of this service varies with the distance covered. Estimation upon request!

### • **Guides**

We offer the services of guides on the International Appalachian Trail (IAT) at a cost of 215\$ a day, including interpretation of the surrounding ecosystems and wildlife and communications and safety equipment. Transport costs of 0.35\$/km for the guide must be added to this rate. As an option, your guide can organize meals at a cost of 35\$ a day for all meals (breakfast, lunch, supper and snacks).

### • **Made-to-measure activities**

Ecotouristic activity packages of various lengths. Lodging in log cabins, park chalets or camping. We can organize a wide variety of activities!

### • **Food Drop Information – Matane Wildlife Reserve**

A food-drop box was set in place at the entrance of Lac Matane Campground and at the entrance of Petit-Sault Campground. Those boxes are hidden. One can either drop the food themselves or use the food-dropping service for \$35 (Lac Matane) or \$45 (Petit-Sault), if the package is sent two weeks in advance. We charged 120 \$ for an on demand or a last minute delivery.

### • **VIA Rail package**

If you would like to travel to our region by train, upon reservation we will go pick you up in Amqui. At first sight the arrival time looks inconvenient – the train gets in at 3h40 a.m. – but that's because you don't know our plan yet! How does a sunrise moose observation session sound to get the visit started? The last day of your stay, you will have time for a good supper with us and to prepare your things before your train pulls out at 11 p.m.
